Qualifications:

- Work experience as a trainer and/or moderator (in adult education)
- Experience in moderating interactive workshops on- and offline
- Ability to work in an international Team and online
- Ability to moderate in English, fluent in English, Arabic is a plus
- Interest in feminist and queer topics
- Experience with cross cultural groups

What we offer: 3200 € for every Workshop (800 € daily rate) plus costs of the hotel and flight, a flat work hierarchy in an international team of 8 employees, if the project funds are approved, the first workshop will be hold in März/ April 2023, the project will start in December 2022.
